Meeting in the Parliament Initiated by the Vice-Speaker

Rusudan Kervalishvili, a vice speaker of Georgian Parliament organized a meeting with the chairmen of parliamentary committees and representatives of the Partnership for Road Safety. Meeting participants reviewed the issue of legislative initiative which considers making use of seatbelts obligatory on all types of roads in Georgia. They also concerned the issue how ready the population is and what can be the obstacles for the law enforcement. The main accent was made on cars of poor technical conditions which are many in Georgia.

Meeting participants underlined the importance of support expressed by Mikheil Saakashvili, President of Georgia in relation to the legislative initiative and assumed that hearings of the abovementioned initiative might be launched in the Parliament this Autumn. But before that time, it is vital to focus on informational campaign which has been taking place for already a year in Georgia.

The campaign has proved to be successful in raising awareness of population in relation to safe drive rules. It aims to create positive public attitude to the law, which will introduce obligation of using seatbelts to protect health and lives of Georgian population. Georgian MPs expressed willingness to take active part in the campaign and to contribute to promotion of seatbelt use.
